CURRICULUM

Focusing on Process, not Content is one of the shifts to common core. Edutopia.org explains it in the following manner: Test scores and grades may not accurately reflect a learner's success or failure, though parents and students spend enormous amounts of time, energy, and money chasing grades and scores because they believe these things are true indicators of learning. Hence, great teachers encouraged by great educational leaders must keep learners focused on the process, not the results. Students chasing scores and grades will lose sight of the learning process and their own growth and development. Like their athlete counterparts, they must focus instead on personal growth within the learning process if they desire better performance. When a language student, for example, focuses on mastering the language rather than making an A, the results will follow.
