COMMON CORE

Multiple measures of assessment is defined as using multiple indicators and multiple sources of evidence to assess student learning. Examples of multiple measures can include extended projects, oral presentations, extended math problems that require application to real world uses, discussions on a given topic or book, history reports, Power Points, writing a paper in a second language, as well as art or music projects. Many of these can be done individually or in groups so long as the purpose is clear. Multiple measures of assessment should be organized so that they can be rescored by other educators as well.
