GOAL SETTING

PBIS

The social emotional learning curriculum helps students learn to recognize emotions in themselves and others. It's designed to teach students to manage strong emotions, build empathy, control impulses and how to solve problems effectively. Using our SWIS data as a tool, we determined 2nd and 5th grade to be the classes we focus on for the remainder of the school year. Mrs. Maturino is working with these grades to determine the best times and days to begin whole class and group lessons.

PARENT'S CORNER

As our PBIS Parent University topic last week was *Honesty*. Parents shared that when it comes to small children and honesty, it's not usually hard to find, but with older children and teens, the truth sometimes becomes more elusive. Parents shared that as parents they are often quick to scold when a child is not saying the truth, but they aren't always so quick to praise for being honest. Even if the child does something wrong, parents should reward honesty with loads of praise and hugs. It will build self-confidence and reinforce positive behavior. Parents are the role models for their children. If the child hears their parents telling a lie or performs a dishonest act they will imitate and will see it as normal because his/her parent is doing it. Also, catching your child being dishonest is a good time to help him correct the mistake. Remind the child that honesty is speaking the truth. Lying is not honest because you are saying something that isn't true. Parents were very engaged in the topic and in sharing strategies that they use at home with their kids.
