### PBIS (POSITIVE BEHAVIOR SUPPORT)

We are in the process of collecting data on how we are using our Eagle Dollars and approximately how many Eagle Dollars students are earning on average. Ideally, each student should be able to earn a minimum of 5 Eagle Dollars every 2 weeks. That would indicate that he/she had at least 5 positive interactions with an adult in that amount of time. Students need to be able to correlate positive behavior to some type of reward, the more immediate the reward, the more likely a student is to behave in a positive manner.
