COMMON CORE

One of the 5C's in shifting over to Common Core Standards is Collaboration. This is much more than sharing ideas with a partner, it is working with others to create a shared project or new idea. Effective collaboration must be taught to students. When students are put into groups to work together, you need to first set up guidelines and inform students of the expectation of collaboration in order for them to collaborate effectively. Remember to take into account any additional support that needs to be provided to English Learners and/or students with special needs.

PBIS

We have made some changes to cafeteria supervision to help students stay orderly. We will now have a supervisor at the door to greet the students as they enter. This should help with entering in an orderly fashion. You should be getting cafeteria slips on a daily basis regarding your student's behavior in there. Talk to them and communicate the feedback you are getting from the cafeteria supervisors. It is important they know what they are doing well and what they still need to work on. Remember that students often need to be retaught multiple times before a behavior becomes a habit.

PARENTS CORNER BY MRS. CISNEROS

- We are in our 4th week of Triple P Parenting classes. Parents are very excited and are attending every week. Last week we had 32 people attending our classes.
- At PBIS Gab University our topic for this week was Compassion. Some of the questions discussed were: How do Parents teach compassion to their kids at home? How do they model Compassion at home? Some of the parents insights included: Parents that teach their kids to care about others have fewer problems and are less likely to get into trouble at school. Students become leaders and in turn, promote respect at School. At school, students will have fewer problems with bullying if we are compassionate to our classmates.

STUDENT SAFETY

Student safety extends beyond the classroom and playground. As students are in transit home, they also need to be safe. This includes crossing the street, walking in an orderly fashion, looking out for bike riders, and being aware of others around them. This is an area that is often overlooked and not addressed often enough. Plan on talking about this with your students this week. When out of our sight, students may forget to be thoughtful about being safe. Have your students write or draw a picture about active ways to stay safe when walking home.
