### CURRICULUM

Hand scoring the Interim Assessments has been a good reflective practice for the grades that have already begun. Looking at our student's responses has given us new insight as to how our instruction in the classroom needs to be adjusted. We not only need to work on improving our student's writing but on teaching how to address all components of a question. Many of the questions on the CAASPP actually contain more than one question within them and students need to know how to respond to all the parts of the question as well as verify that they have actually responded to the overall question asked.

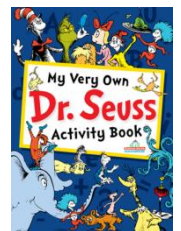
